

# COVID-19 Protocol

In effect from July 2020

The Beach Deck will be operating with the safety of everyone as our top priority. We have put the following measures in place to ensure the health & safety of our customers and staff:

### General

- We encourage customers to use the hand sanitiser provided on their arrival.
- All staff will receive training on our new standards regarding COVID-19 health & safety.
- Face coverings to be worn by staff where appropriate.
- Increased cleaning schedules of all public areas, with an emphasis on deep cleaning frequent contact surfaces.
- We will operate with a one-way flow system Entrance via the ramp and exit via the steps.
- Cutlery will be brought to your table with your food and we will be using sachets of condiments for the time being.
- We ask that children remain the responsibility of their accompanying adult and that they ensure children stick to social distancing guidance while on our premises.
- Following recent Government guidance, we will be taking a record of our customers contact details and storing them securely, following all data protection regulations, for 21 days. This is for us to help with the NHS test and trace.
- We will not be taking bookings.

#### **Customer Toilets**

- We have increased our cleaning routine for our customer toilets.
- The regular cleaning and checks will be documented and displayed in the toilets for you to see.
- We encourage diners to use the hand sanitiser provided before entry to the customer toilets.
- Beach Deck toilets will only be available to Beach Deck customers once they have a table.

## **Indoor Dining**

- It will be table service on our indoor tables.
- Where possible you will have a designated member of staff take your order and bring you your food to minimise the number of people you will encounter.
- Tables will not be laid up as usual. Cutlery, glasses and sauces will be brought to your table as needed
- Sachets of condiments will be used for the time being.
- In between uses the table will be sanitised.
- Staff will be fully trained on safe service and social distancing procedures.
- Face coverings to be worn by staff where appropriate.



### The Decking

- You will be greeted at the top of our ramp by a member of our team who will show you to your table.
- You will be able to order and pay for your food and drink from our outside order point, don't forget your table number!
- We request that only one member of your group comes up to place the order to keep the socially distanced queue to a minimum.
- We will bring your food, drinks, cutlery and condiments to your table.

# Take Away

- A limited take away menu will be available to order from 4pm-8pm, by phone or via our website.
- You will need to wait on the beach for your food to be available.
- We request that only one member of your group comes in to collect your order.
- We encourage customers to use the bins provided.

If prior to you visiting us, you have suffered from any of the following symptoms:

- High Temperature
- New continuous cough
- Loss of taste or smell

We kindly ask that you do not pay us a visit and follow all current government guidelines.

We will continue to review these procedures in-line with the guidance provided by the UK Government and Public Health England.
